3-4 JUDGES

- 1. First call for the 5 & 6 grade Girls will be made at the start of the meet after the first call for the Girls 1600 Meter. When the 5th & 6th Girls have completed their first flight of jumps, contact the meet Director for first call for 7th & 8th grade girls. Make first call for boys after first flight of girls.
- 2. Athletes may sign-in advance of their jump time and may leave to run a track event. Remind them to return as soon as possible.
- 3. Each competitor gets 3 practice jumps at the opening height only:

GIRLS

5th 3'2"

6th 3'2"

7th 3'4"

8th 3'6"

**BOYS** 

5th 3'6"

6th 3'6"

7th 3'8"

8th 3'10"

Raise bar 2" at a time until only 4 or less competitors remain, thereafter 1" at a time.

Athletes may PASS at any time at any height. (Height will marked with a "P")

- 4. Record all jumps on event sheet. Mark each miss with an <u>"0".</u> Each jump made will be marked with an <u>"X".</u> In case of a tie the winning height will be determined by the number of misses.
- 5. Competitors:
- \*\* May only jump off only one (1) foot.
- \*\* All jumps in which the competitor jumps off of both his/her feet shall be considered as *missed attempts*.
